

Sparkling wine:

Frederic Maletrez, Champagne Brut Reserve 1'er Cru - France 649
Full bodied and dry sparkling with notes of freshly baked bread, grilled lemon Unripe green apples, vanilla and stony minerality.

Gosset, Champagne Grande Reserve – France 1095
*Dry and light with notes of lemon zest
Unripe yellow apples, white flowers and xhalk.*

Gosset, Champagne Grand Rosé - France 1195
Very dry sparkling with notes of strawberry, rose petals, raspberry.

Rosé:

Figuiere, Magali Rosé – Provence, France 545
Dry and light body with notes of unripe peaches and nectarines, Rose petals and lavender.

White wine:

Fernand Engel, Gewürtztraminer Reserve – Alsace, France 545
Semi sweet, with taste of grapefruit, tangerine and roses.

Louise Damiron, Chardonnay – Languedoc, France 445
Dry and full-bodied chardonnay, with notes of peaches, cantaloupe, pineapple ripe yellow apples and lemon.

Villebois, Touraine Sauvignon Blanc – Loire, France 545
Light bodied and dry with notes of green pears, white flowers, gooseberries and asparagus.

Domaine Roux, Bourgogne Blanc – Bourgogne, France 645
Dry and full-bodied chardonnay, with notes green and yellow apples, pears, with flinty minerality and butter.

Fritsch, Grüner Veltliner – Wagram, Austria 545
Light and very dry with notes of lemon and lime, grape, pepper and stony minerality.

Elena Walch – Pinot Grigio – Alto Adige, Italy 545
Medium bodied and fruit-driven with notes of ripe pears and peaches along with nectarines.

Collemassari – Vermentino “Melacce” – Tuscany, Italy 545
*Dry and medium bodied and with notes of white and yellow flowers, spices
apricot and quince.*

Markus Molitor – Riesling “Haus Klosterberg” – Mosel, Germany 545
*Semi sweet and with notes of white and yellow flowers, spices
apricot and quince.*

Red wine:

Domaine Ferrand, Cotes du Rhône – Rhône, France 545
Medium bodied and dry bramble, blackberries, dried herbs, chocolate and spices.

Bertrand Ambroise, Bourgogne Rouge – Bourgogne, France 645
*Light bodied very dry, notes of cranberry, raspberry, blueberry,
Pepper and cedar.*

Chateau Puy-Razac, Saint-Emilion Grand Cru – Bordeaux, France 645
*Full bodied and dry with notes of cassis, bramble, bell peppers, tomato leaf
and stony minerality.*

Châteauneuf-du-Pape Le Clocher – France 995
*Full bodied and fruity. The nose is characterized by red fruits and
warm spices. An obvious choice for red meat, game and mature cheeses.*

Amarone classic Masua Di Jago – Italy 995
*Power and juice and great depth in the scent with dark plums,
blackberries and chocolate. The taste fills the entire mouth cavity with
intense tannins and a high fruit intensity.*

Antonin Guyon, Gevrey-Chambertin – Bourgogne, France 1495
*light bodied and dry with notes of redcurrant, raspberry, barnyard, rose petals,
pepper and charred wood.*

Recchia – Valpolicella Ripasso – Veneto, Italy 545
Medium bodied and fruit-driven with notes of ripe cassis, strawberry, chocolate.

Baigorri – Rioja Crianza – Rioja Spain 545
Full bodied and with notes of black currant, red currant, leather and sweet spices.

Borgo Al Passo Chianti – Italy 545
*The wine smells beautifully of ripe sweet dark fruit; plums, black cherries,
Blackberries.*
